- SACSCOC requirements for institutional effectiveness and KSU planning efforts

Purpose

- Evaluates the effectiveness of academic programs through a systematic review.
- Addresses the quality, viability, and productivity in teaching and learning, scholarship, and service.
- Allows KSU to make judgments about the future of academic programs within a culture of evidence.
